Dear friends and parishioners,

Today (Sunday) we celebrate First Reconciliation with the second-graders from our parish school and our religious-education program.

I want to take this opportunity to thank many of you for cards, gifts, and plenty of Christmas goodies! Your kindness is much appreciated.

The joy of Christmas was tempered, as you know, with the sudden death of Fr. Ron Warnimont, who had been living with me here at St. Clement since early October. It was a temporary placement for him as he worked in the chancery (Tribunal) and awaited a new assignment as pastor in the spring. But I was enjoying his company, and he helped me out on several occasions with children's confessions and with daily Mass. We've also worked together for several years now as members of the Priests' Council for the Toledo Diocese. His death on St. Stephen's Day (Dec. 26) was certainly unexpected. Quite a large number of the priests were able to make it down to St. Nicholas Church in Miller City for his funeral, where we had gathered for his father's funeral in August.
